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yeah hello everyone This is Daniel Giamario for our monthly video blog, and this is going to be a shorter one than usual. I just wanted to speak a little bit and show some charts that's similar to what I've just written in social media over the last few days. And I'm here today once again helped out by Awen, our managing director. And so, he'll be there to help with the slides and have a little bit of discussion on this. I do I suggest that when you see this in the newsletter that the article there that also covers some of the same information exactly follows it and you can also find that on our under "Founders Corner" on our website.

Okay so let's first look at the charts of the New Moon and the Solstice. because there is something quite interesting. I know this is slightly off topic but it's going to set off it's going to give us a background on understanding this update on the U.S. Pluto return in upcoming U.S., Chiron return, which are our main subject. So let's start off by looking at the Solstice chart. I wanted to mention because there's such a closeness to the date and the exact point of the Solstice and the New Moon point that this actually calls up something that the Native Americans and other indigenous

people around the world thought was super important, which is when there was a convergence or a connection between an Equinox or Solstice point and a New Moon or a Full Moon, it was a way of hooking up the energy of the Moon with the solar cycle. and this would have been considered a really big one for this to happen like this. And I wanted to point that out because it gives a kind of a larger context to the understanding of the U.S. chart and the in the U.S. last exact Chiron return so just notice a few things here, we're going to see these themes often. Over these next few minutes we see a Sagittarius Moon, we see the Saturn position at 21° Aquarius there is the alignment with those planets in early Capricorn. Keep that in mind the Sun and Venus and Mercury and there's Pluto at 27° Capricorn, our good friend Mars still there in Gemini, where we'll be for a few more months so, and then we also noticed that at the point of the Solstice, in alignment that we've been talking about all year, shows up, which is the North Node with the Nodal Axis with Uranus, which has been a theme all along.

All right, so let's look at the New Moon now. So this is just the very next day and here, as I mentioned it's like then the ancient ways of understanding this is that if there is a New Moon or a Full Moon right at a Solstice point, then wow, we're really onto something. This is a big calendric shift and high ceremony I guess we could say. So just noting here the some of the same things, the early Capricorn Moon at 13° 2"

Capricorn and all that whole lineup in Capricorn. Oh and then, we'll see the importance of that when we look at the U.S. chart next, and keep in mind also, Saturn at 21° Aquarius and of course, the one that we're focusing on here first, which is the 27° 23" Capricorn Pluto position. And we'll note here that at the New Moon at least, if you're in Los Angeles and Scorpio Rising. As you know that depending on where you are at the point of the New Moon or the Solstice. The angles change about every two hours to different signs. So you can't always say. "Well, gee, I'm in New York and well, Scorpio Rising New Moon not necessarily, but all the other stuff will be the same and last, but not least is to keep put your attention on Jupiter that's just moved into Aries and the Chiron position at 11° Aries that comes into our story in a few minutes.

Okay so let's look at the U.S. chart been looking at this now for a good number of years as lots of other people and you'll notice here the natal Pluto is 27° 33" Capricorn and there have been three exact conjunctions and the last one is coming up here in a few days and we'll look at the chart of that I'm in a moment, however in attributing the initiatory window of the of Pluto conjunct U.S. Pluto if we use the same strategy the same approach the same Criterion is on an individual's chart then this is absolutely not over. Actually the way we would look at the almost two-year initiatory window, it will actually extend all the way until October 10<sup>th</sup>. 2023, when Pluto will

retrograde back to 27° and some minutes, past the natal position.

So it's kind of, it's we really have to say that 2022 and 2023 are without question "the Bullseye," the deepest descent, the greatest intensity of the event that can only happen with a Pluto return, which is about every 246-7-8 years, depending on the retrograde cycles and so on. And so this is huge. I mean obviously in our school what we've talked about for a long time is that Pluto aspects and Pluto transits and this is a big one, has to do with facing Shadow, has to do with composting what needs to be composted. Its something that brings out Secrets, but that ultimately, if there's an opportunity, if a person has the courage or if a country has the courage to face their Shadow material and to bring out the secrets, to be willing to be exposed, that out of it can come in empowerment as it does on individual horoscopes. And that will be what the 2023 time period could be if the time frame, which ends in a few days is not taken seriously as an important initiation because when you compost, out of the compost comes New Life transformation. Do why don't we oh just keep in mind also 27° Aquarius there for the natal Moon position as you'll see in a moment. So let's go to the actual Pluto return chart Awen.

So, if you happen to be in Arizona well then, it's 8 in the morning, which is the exact point. And remember, this is the third exact Pluto conjunction, with the U.S. natal Pluto and then, as I've just mentioned, there will be a final

portion of the Pluto initiatory process that will extend until October of next year.

So notice here, some of our main themes. Actually, if you remember that the US chart has a whole lot of stuff in Cancer. Here we have the Sun and Venus and Mercury and are in Capricorn I mean the U.S. Mercury is almost exactly opposite that the Sun is almost exactly opposite that. I don't know if you hear that, a helicopter is just going over right now, that's all right doesn't happen very often and then also, you'll note Saturn at 27° 05" Aquarius and something that I've been writing about in the last few years is the U.S. Moon position is 27° Aquarius. And so, we're approaching that point that only happens every 30 years, of Saturn on the U.S. Moon, which is yet another factor to keep in mind. The U.S. has just finished it's Neptune opposition, so that part is finished. So there's really a lot of stuff on the table here and we don't want to overlook the fact that on the U.S. chart. Go back to the U.S. chart for a moment, and you'll see what I mean.

Look at Venus, Jupiter, and the Sun, and Mercury. And so basically the Capricorn planets are you know all in opposition to the natal chart and the thing I want to place your attention on now is look at Saturn at 14° Libra, and look at Chiron in 20° Aries, opposite. And then we can see that Chiron and Saturn are both *squaring* the U.S.. Sun-Saturn square the Sun, it's almost one degree, I mean that's a real close

one. and then we have Chiron squaring both the Sun and Mercury So this is then kind of taking us to what will be talked about a lot by most astrologers—the 2023-2024 Chiron return to the U.S. chart. Now it does turn out that there are three exact points in 2024, actually one that goes into 2025, I'm not mistaken here. Yeah, there's three exact conjunctions that happen April 20, 2024, November 8, 2024 and then the last one is February 18, 2025. But what I'm suspecting, based on something I'll bring up in a moment, is that and I think other astrologers that I've that I've looked at have kind of agreed with us that we could say the Chiron returned to the U.S. chart, actually begins in 2023 and that's what the chart we're looking at right now, July 23<sup>rd</sup>. 2023. And you'll note here a lot of the things that we've been talking about all along. But in particular, I want to be put placing the attention here on the degree of Chiron 19° 57" Aries, beyond the scope of our short sharing here today is the fact that if we went back into February March April. that's the time period where Jupiter in Aries will go across Chiron and so, there's also already, the warming up of Chiron by Jupiter in Aries BUT by the time it gets July, **Jupiter** is already in Taurus, but this 1957. that's really close to the natal position really close which is 2008 Aries and so therefore if we were looking at a chart of a you know a country or actually, in a more expanded view of looking at an individual initiatory process, it could be said that the window of initiation for the Chiron process to the U.S..

chart, begins here until July 23<sup>rd</sup> and it would actually extend then until that final conjunction, which is in 2025. which February 18, 2025, and that was just that would represent the initiatory window that could be applied to an individual chart also so, okay one more thing here just to keep in mind placing the attention on that 19° 57" Aries, which in July could be thought of as the beginning of the Chiron return, look at something very interesting in 2024, so let's look at that Eclipse chart, now this is really quite astounding BUT I mean it's really hard to imagine it's got you can't just make this kind of stuff up I mean as the universe makes it up right. So here we have an over four-minute long Solar Eclipse, Total Solar Eclipse, which will cross starting in Mexico and through the U.S. and up to through Eastern Canada, it's being called "The Great North American Eclipse," and it's happening at 19° 24" Aries. Now this is not a misprint. Look at Chiron 19° 24" Aries, not a misprint, you know, so this, we could say, not only is it The Great North American Total Solar Eclipse, but also it's the Chiron Return-U.S. Eclipse. Remember, that's almost exactly the same as the 2023. in July. start date, This is going to be quite amazing. And then also, the Nodes. I mean look South Node is at 15° Libra, really close to the U.S. Saturn, and all the configurations are kind of highlighted here, particularly the ones associated with the natal chart. So. I thought it would be very important at this point to bring this to your, to all of

your attention, maybe the last word here would be.

So what according to in our school what is the purpose of a Chiron return and this is the fifth one for the United States, I know that there's many different ways that different astrologers use Chiron. How I see it is that it is not a wounder, it is a teacher, shamanic teacher, and what its job is to first point out where fracture points are, where challenges are, where *essential* challenges are. Pointing it out and then at various times and it cycles offering teaching as far as how to heal it and that healing is why we attribute Chiron or the underworld dimension. It's not allopathic, it's like you're having to surrender to what you may not want to surrender to and so therefore, each Chiron return is an examination of what are some of the challenges to the United States, from the very beginning and no time here. I don't want to...I want to suggest here as we complete this short sharing, that goes along with the article, is that if you haven't had a chance to look at the extensive collection of articles and videos that have been done on the U.S. chart, which include all these topics that I'm talking about right now that I'm updating you on, that will be, that is included with this video and in the newsletter. And also, in the social media post is that ability to access all of that, to prepare you for this amazing remarkable astonishing aspects in 2023 and 2024, right. So Awen, what if any comments or questions before we complete this?

A - I'm just really grateful for the Shamanic-Astrology Underworld understanding, that it has the transformational component to it, that it could be seen as a pretty dark time coming up, but I just like to highlight the fact that there is some hope.

D - Well yeah, it's kind of exactly, if I'm talking to somebody, an individual who's in a Chiron return, it's getting a person's attention. This is the time in order to handle a particular issue, and then, if they don't, if they don't take that time period seriously as a way to heal, it's called 'healer heal thyself,' You know, a country heal itself, you know, that kind of thing, then you can expect the universe to make the next move. So then, there will be events that will force the action on someone. So we don't, we never say in a Chiron return that somebody's going to get sick, but if they need to have an illness to get their attention, it's not endemic, it's something to get their attention, so that the healing can happen, and so they can distill a kind of elixir from that. which then becomes the gift of that country, or that person right. So that's what will be interesting to tune into. There's no way in either one of these two to "light wash" them, or go into a place of, "Oh it's only 5D, you know." You have to look at all three worlds, including the Underworld, and to not be in any denial. This is the time period, all Underworld cycles are about no denial. Otherwise, if you have any denial, it manifests as Jung put it, you know "In a time period when there are no gods and goddesses,

they show up as our diseases." And that would appear to an individual or a or a country.

So there you have it, and we're certainly open for any comments, feedback on this. If any of you have a chance to say this before tomorrow's seminar, that also might go, can go into the question and answer that happens at the end of our investigation of the Cycles of 2023.
